How to Make a Caucus Site Accessible

- Proper signage leading to caucus location both inside and outside of building
- Clearly marked accessible parking
- Signage to direct individuals to drop-off parking in front of main entrance
- Doorways have no thresholds over 1/4", are 36" wide, and can be opened with minimal effort
- Door handles are no higher than 48" and operate with a closed fist
- Ramps are available to use and have a gentle slope
- All stairs have non-slip treads and continuous rails on both sides
- If the caucus room isn't on the first floor, working elevators must be available to use
- The caucus room has 36" aisles and adequate space between tables, chairs, and other furniture
- There is room at the end of aisles for wheelchairs, service animals, etc.
- If there are objects hanging 5" or more from the ceiling or wall, put a cone on the floor to alert people who are blind or low vision
